

SUMMARY OF MARCH 21, 2023 MEETING OF SESSION

THIS SUMMARY IS NOT THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING.

Stated Session Meeting March 21, 2023 (Not the minutes)

Session of First Presbyterian Church of Lee's Summit held its regular meeting on March 21, 2023 in the Center Room. Moderator, Rev. Bonnie Grabowski called the meeting to order at 6:38PM by praying the Breakthrough Prayer in unison. **Deaths - John** Leheney, member, passed away December 31, 2022.

Stewart Black - member, passed away January 13, 2023.

Baptisms - Emersyn Rose and Olin Anderson Hart (twins), children of Alec and Sarah Hart, members, were baptized on Sunday, March 19, 2023 by Rev. Dr. Alex Wales.

February Financials: Financial statement as reported by Finance.

<u>Financial Report</u> – February continued to be Very Positive. Income was \$15,495 **more** than Expenses. Monthly Pledged giving was \$7,826 **more** but Non-pledged giving was \$1,210 **less** than budgeted and Per Capita was \$606 **more** than budgeted. Expenses were \$6,988 **less** than budgeted. Our Investments **lost** \$5,969 but are still \$6,665 **more** than at the beginning of the year. Checking Balance was \$47,595.34 with Outstanding Liabilities of \$7,742.93 leaving \$39,852.41 available in checking.

Session continued to review and update our Policies and Procedures. Five more were approved. Three remain in review and hope to be approved at the April 25 session meeting.

- Building, Grounds & Safety: MOTION to request session approval of Transporting Members & Others and Trip Request Policy & Form. Motion approved.
- Finance Action Team (AT): MOTION to request session approval of the Financial Policy. Motion Approved
- Personnel Committee: MOTION to request session approval of Personnel and Parental Leave Policies.
 Motion approved.

Three other Motions were reviewed and acted on during the meeting.

- Fellowship-Outreach AT: MOTION add a comment on electronic sign inviting public to use our playground and post permanent sign(s) near playground saying "Public is Welcome at Your Own Risk No Supervision Provided". Motion approved.
- Finance AT: MOTION to approve purchase of 2 Octaves of Hand Chimes up to \$6,723.44, the amount of donated funds available. The latest cost estimate is \$6,141.50. Motion Approved MOTION to accept the American Church Group Insurance renewal after changing our deductible from \$2,500 to \$15,000 which will save \$2,563 and result in an annual premium of \$20,758. Motion approved.

Rev. Bonnie Grabowski Moderated. She reviewed and discussed our options for pastor support, explained the relatively new contract called a "Bridge Pastor Covenant", and provided a copy of the contract format. This is a contract between the session and the pastor for a 3-month period. Duties of the pastor are agreed to between the pastor and session and can range from just preaching on Sunday's and moderating session meetings to full time weekly support. The other option is Pulpit supply on a week to week basis. Session is looking at both options and will be contacting pastors to determine our best path forward until we hire a permanent pastor.

Have You Paid Your Annual Per Capita?

As you may or may not know, each Presbyterian church is responsible to pay Per Capita for every church member every year. In 2022, we had to pay \$7,901 out of our operating budget to cover our church members who did not pay their Per Capita. It would be a tremendous help to our church if each member would pay this small amount of \$43.94 per member. Think of the extra projects we could do if we didn't have to take approximately \$8,000 out of our operating budget each year to pay these membership fees.

Special thanks to those who have paid, we are so thankful for your support. If you haven't paid, we would greatly appreciate your payment of \$43.94 for each family church member for 2023. Be sure to note "Per Capita" in the memo line on your check.
